Location

Housing

On campus residence halls house 120 students in double rooms with air conditioning, twin beds, desks, storage area, local telephone service and micro/fridge. Students must bring or purchase bed linens and towels. There is a laundry room in the dorm. The cafeteria is centrally located and students are required to buy the 15 meals/ week plan (Monday-Friday). Meals are not provided before the semester, or between semesters, during holidays or after the semester ends. The dorm is closed during holiday breaks.

Sports

The intramural program conducts league play against students from other colleges in flag football, volleyball, basketball, and softball. You can also participate in tennis, golf, bowling, badminton, and basketball.

Activities


