# Location

Gainesville is a student city, much like Ann Arbor, Michigan or Austin, Texas. Concerts, festivals, nightlife, outdoor recreation and Top 10 intercollegiate football entertain Santa Fe and University of Florida students. Crescent Beach, an hour and a half away, is nicknamed "Gainesville Beach." Arts, athletics and activities are an exciting part of campus life at Santa Fe Community College.

The college offers theatrical productions, a seasonal performing arts series, an art gallery, a teaching zoo and the annual SFCC Spring Arts Festival, which attracts 110,000 people to Gainesville.

An active student Government Association organizes events and activities, and is a respected voice for students in campus matters.

### Climate

The college is located in a warm setting that blends into the unique scenery of North Florida. Santa Fe has won awards for landscaping that preserves the trees, ponds and natural features of the campus. Santa Fe also has the Andrews Center in Starke and Blount Center in downtown Gainesville. The two centers are located in restored historical buildings. The Gainesville lifestyle means plenty of activities to choose from. It also means that our town welcomes students with different interests and backgrounds.

## Housing

The student accommodations or apartments are located directly across the street from Santa Fe CC. Students share a 4 bedroom/4 bath in single room accommodations. Each apartment is equipped with an alarm system, fully furnished, with high-speed internet access, private balcony, private bathrooms, full size washer/dryer. Includes electric, water & cable TV w/HBO. The apartment community also provides a swimming pool with tanning deck, computer/study center, state of the art fitness center, clubhouse, game and activity room, basketball, tennis, sand volleyball and picnic areas.

#### Meals

Santa Fe apartments are furnished with fully equiped kitchens. Students share the kitchen with 3 others and cook their own meals. These accommodations are self catering and meal program is not included in the price.

#### Sports

Intramural sports include swimming and diving, basketball, and volleyball. Intercollegiate athletics program consists of men's and women's basketball, women's fast pitch softball and men's baseball. Santa Fe athletes have been named to All-State and All-America teams. Santa Fe teams have won conference and state championships and have gone on to national rankings.
